A public information (non-statutory) meeting was held on Tuesday, June 10 at the Civic Centre during which the consultant presented their final report. The report will be on the City website soon. A staff report, hopefully including implementation plan and funding sources, will be presented to Development Services Committee in the Fall. Ultimately, a new Secondary Plan will be developed by the City. The consultant report contained a number of good ideas, but also left a number of questions unanswered. During the summer, the URA Directors will be gathering ideas and comments from our members, for presentation to staff and DSC in the fall.
